

## Free condoms and lube

Under 25? Get free condoms and lube with a C-Card!

The C-Card allows you to get free condoms from a range of places e.g. some colleges, shops, clinics and pharmacies.

## **Emergency contraception**

The emergency contraceptive pill (sometimes called 'the morning after pill') can be taken up to 5 days after sex without a condom (or a contraceptive failure) to reduce the chance of pregnancy.

It is available from sexual health clinics and from some pharmacies.
