Latest Service Information - Monkeypox

Due to Monkeypox precautions, we are asking everyone to call us for any sexual health bookings or enquiries.

We are not offering walk-in services at any of our clinics.

All appointments must be booked in advance via our phone line, 0300 124 5022.

We are advising that service users DO NOT attend a clinic if they have:

- An unexplained rash on any part of their body
- Fever

– New lump/s in the groin, neck or armpits

Patients should stay at home and call 111 in these instances.

Change of Termination of Pregnancy Service Provider – BPAS to NUPAS

NUPAS have been chosen as the provider for termination of pregnancy services across Staffordshire from April 2022. Prior to April 2022, this service was provided by BPAS.

Service users can self-refer into the service by calling 0333 004 6666, there is no need for a GP referral. Their Contact Centre is open 7 days per week 8am-8pm.
