We are not offering walk-in services at any of our clinics.

All appointments must be booked in advance via our phone line, 0808 178 0955.

If someone is at high risk of Monkeypox and would like a vaccine please advise them to keep an eye on the website for information, and when the vaccine is available, to call their local sexual health clinic to book an appointment.
