## **C-Card Reminder Sheet**

### How to register

- Service user needs to fill in the white section of the form with their information
- 2. Professional checks all fields are filled and legible
- 3. Professional works through checklist in grey area on the form with service user
- Professional fills in venue, staff member, date issued, C-Card number and ticks appropriate registration type
- 5. Issue C-Card and C-Card pack(s) to service user, tick off first box(es) on back of card

### Points to cover

- Rights in a relationship
- Sexual health services & contraception are still available if you're under 16
- Legal age for sex/sexual contact is 16
- Nobody under 13 can consent to sex
- Alcohol and drugs affect a person's capacity to consent
- Sexual health services are confidential

## How to distribute

- 1. Fill in date, C-Card number and visit number on distribution form
- 2. Issue C-Card pack(s) and tick off visit number box(es) on back of C-Card
- If last visit, offer to register for new C-Card or signpost to nearest registration venue or online registration at www.openclinic.org.uk (ages 16+)

#### **Under 16s**

- Fraser assessment
   (Young person understands what they're accessing, risks and legalities around sex under 16 and professional feels distribution of condoms is in the young person's best interest)
- Risk assessment (If you are concerned, follow internal safeguarding procedures)
- Condom demonstration
