What is PrEP?

Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) is a drug taken by HIV-negative people before and after sex that prevents HIV transmission.

Who should take it?

PrEP can be used by people of all genders and sexualities.

How can I get PrEP?

PrEP is available from sexual health clinics, free of charge.

Patients attending a sexual health clinic will be seen by a specialist clinician, who will undertake a HIV test, to ensure the patient is HIV negative. There will also be tests for STIs, Hepatitis B and C, and kidney function.
